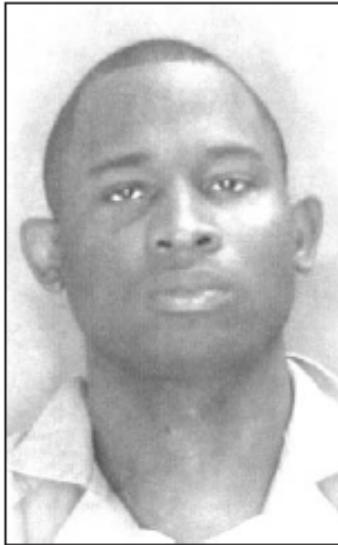


# Suspect from WayneNet drug bust turns himself in; Police seek public help in locating Tysean J. Harris

When members of the Wayne County Narcotics Enforcement Team completed their county-wide sweep of street level drug dealers this past December, two defendants were not located immediately and were then on the run.

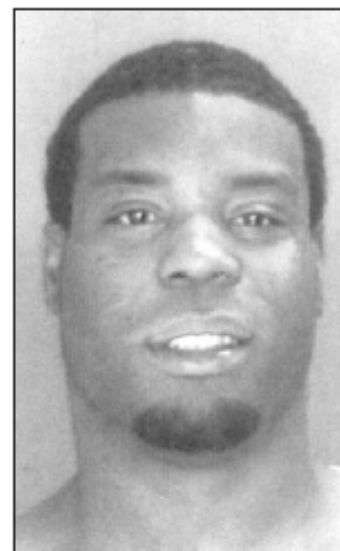
One defendant, a **Reginald D. Weems**, age 25, of 8929 Lyons-Merengo Road, Lyons turned himself in Friday to the Lyons Police Department. Weems was wanted on a Wayne County Court indictment warrant for drug sales in the Village of Lyons.

Weems was arraigned in County Court and was remanded to the Wayne County Jail on \$5,000 cash bail.

remaining defendant, a **Tysean J. Harris**, age 30, of #137 Columbia Street, in Clyde. Police advise that Harris is wanted on a Wayne County Court indictment warrant for multiple counts of cocaine sales in the Clyde area. Harris is known to associate with friends
