

On Wednesday, April 18<sup>th</sup>, 2007, WayneNET members, acting on arrest warrants issued by Newark Village Justice Daniel Barrett, arrested Matthew R. Sherman, age 21 of 346 Murray Street in Newark and charged him with two counts of Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance 3rd degree and two counts of Criminal Sale of a Controlled Substance 3rd degree, all class B felonies. Sherman was arraigned by Justice Barrett and released on \$1000 cash bail. He will return to Newark Village Court on May 2nd, 2007.



The arrest is the result of investigations done pursuant to the Operation Impact Tools Initiative Grant awarded to WayneNET. The grant allows WayneNet members to continue their efforts at reducing violent crime and drug trafficking within Wayne County in targeted areas.
