

Webster man caught in the act, selling cocaine in Macedon business parking lot



Members of the Wayne County Narcotics Enforcement Team (WayneNET) reported the Thursday night arrest of Aqiyl Hinds, age 26, of 658 Finching Field Lane, Webster, for Criminal Sale of a Controlled Substance in the Third Degree, Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the Third Degree (two counts), Conspiracy in the Fourth Degree, and Criminally Using Drug Paraphernalia in the Second Degree.

The arrest follows a two-month investigation into Hinds' cocaine sales in Wayne County. Hinds was arrested in a retail establishment parking lot in the Town of Macedon while he was selling cocaine to another person.

Police recovered a total of 11 grams of cocaine in Hind's vehicle, digital scales, packaging material, and cut agent. Hinds, who is unemployed and has no prior arrest record, was arraigned in the Town of Macedon Court and was remanded to the Wayne County Jail on \$5000 cash bail. Police report that additional arrests are pending in this matter.
